

1. Enrollment / payment

The definite enrollment / reservation is completed upon settling the invoice. In case a partial payment was agreed, the definite enrollment / reservation is completed upon settlement of the partial payment. In such cases the tour is considered as reserved and booked.

2. Cancellation

The trip can be cancelled up to 90 days before its start. The cancellation fees up to 90 days will include those expenses already incurred to biker-on-tour (i.e. flight costs, hotel reservation, biker rental, etc.) and a flat cancellation fee of US \$ 500.- per motorcycle.

In case of cancellations made for less than 90 days before travel, no reimbursements will be made. Should you cancel your started trip during the journey, for whatever reasons you might have, no reimbursements will be made. Additional costs, as for salvage, search or special return travel will have to be covered by the participant. We recommend the purchase of a trip cancellation insurance.

Cancellation by biker-on-tour

Occurrences that disable a trip participation (such as fatal illness, accident, death or other unforeseen incidents) will allow a reimbursement of the paid amounts to biker-on-tour. Further claims made to biker-on-tour will be denied. Should the minimum number of participants, in the case of group tours, not be reached up to 60 days before travel starts, the trip can be cancelled by biker-on-tour.

3. Travel visa / travel documents

Should a country require an entry visa, it will be the participant's responsibility to take care of it. Furthermore the participant is wholly responsible for the complete and correct travelling documents (i.e. esta-form, driver's license etc.) Biker-on-tour will stay at your disposal for any further questions.

4. Insurances

The tour prices do not include any personal insurances. Please check whether or not you are sufficiently covered through your liability-, medicare- and accident insurances for the respective countries of travel. The insurance for the motorcycles are included in the respective motorcycle rentals (see Eagle Rider resp. rental offices).

5. Disclaimer

Biker-on-tour will not be liable for any changes in the tour programs, which are due to weather, governmental measures, strikes, acts of war, delays by third parties, motor vehicle breakdowns etc. In case of necessary motorcycle repairs or breakdowns, the terms and conditions of the rental contract issued by the rental office company will apply. The contract conclusion for the vehicle rental is being completed directly between the rental office and the travel participant. Biker-on-tour is completely excluded of any liability.

In the case of any further bookings for local trips or excursions (i.e. round tour flights, helicopter trips, entertainments etc.) biker-on-tour will be excluded of any liability. Furthermore, biker-on-tour cannot take any responsibility nor be held liable for any omissions by the participant or loss of any personal belongings (theft etc.).

6. Changes of the tour

For reasons of security (weather conditions, street conditions, political riots, etc.) biker-on-tour reserves all rights to change the planned route.

7. Objections and complaints

These must be addressed on-sight and directly to the guide of biker-on-tour. Swiss law will be applied for any disputes between the travel participants and biker-on-tour (Prisma AG)
